CHAMPAGNE

- 10 Taittinger NV** £80.00
Founded in 1734, this delicate, fine-bubbled champagne has a distinguished history. 4 years ageing on the lees brings complexity and roundness to the wine, making it dry, light, elegant and expressive. with aromas of fruit and brioche.
- 15 Taittinger Vintage 2013 Champagne** £120.00
Taittinger produces a Vintage Champagne only when the harvest has been of exceptional quality. Only released after several years of cellar ageing, allowing the aromas to mature slowly and the length and complexity of the wine to develop. It is an elegant but complex cuvée, the rich blend of Grand Cru Chardonnay and Pinot Noir shows off the quality of the great vintages with their extra body and concentration of fruit.
- 20 Taittinger Prestige Brut Rosé Champagne** £100.00
Taittinger is one of the last great independent Champagne Houses owned and actively managed by the family named on the label. The family are guardians of Taittinger's style, quality and integrity. With its subtle balance of soft red fruits and crisp acidity, this wine is velvety, full-bodied and refined.
- 25 Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut NV** £120.00
Unlike most Rosé Champagne, the basis of Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut is obtained by drawing the juice from black grapes in the vat, not only by blending red and white wines. Cellared for at least four year.
- 30 Dom Perignon 2010** £300.00
Vintage Champagne from the mythical Maison Dom Perignon. Champagne with a perfectly contained power. This cuvée contains a secret blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.
- 35 Salon Blanc du Blanc 2007** £500.00
One of the world's best rated and exclusive Champagnes. Salon produces the only wine in the world not to be made every year and is on average only declared about 3 times a decade. Extremely delicate, subtly rich and with age (20-30 years or more) it develops notable aromas and flavours of coconut, walnut, coffee. and vanilla. All Champagne lovers should experience Salon at some stage – exquisite.
- 40 Delamotte Brut NV** £65.00
Delamotte is a real insider's Champagne, though it is one of the very best in the region. Quite rich, bold and toasty, although still refined. Lovely warm toast and vanilla notes on the palate, which is rounded and delicious.
- ## SPARKLING WINE
- 45 Ambriel Classic Cuvee Brut Traditional Method NV** £75.00
Made the same way as Champagne and a bronze medal winner at the international wine show. This feels like a celebration of Englishness with its uplifting orchard fruit and summer berry notes. Bright and elegant, with a refreshing creamy mousse and long, toasty finish.
- 50 Prosecco Sylvos DOC Treviso Le Colture Brut NV, Italy** £35.00
Le Colture, based in Valdobbiadene, are true sparkling wine experts. Over 500 years of experience have led this old-established family to produce a world class Prosecco - light and delicate, with notes of orchard fruit and white flowers.
- 55 Sparkling Rose Le Colture Brut NV D.O.C.G** £36.00
With 500 years of experience, the Ruggieri family are veritable sparkling wine experts. Located in Valdobbiadene, in the heartland of Prosecco production, their state of the art winery has produced this attractive, pink sparkling rose, with a delicate mousse and ripe, red berry flavour.

WHITES

CHARDONNAY

- 60 Chardonnay Bodega Ruca Malen** £45.00
Grown at high altitude on a handful of excellent vineyard sites in the prestigious Uco Valley, where grapes benefit from intense luminous mountain sunshine together with cooler nights to yield fruits with great concentration. Burgundian in style, this Chardonnay has a delicately floral and apricoty nose with a soft and gently creamy palate.
- 65 Chablis Vincent Dampt, Burgundy, France** £55.00
Pale lemon in colour, the nose shows soft jasmine notes and ripe fruit. The palate is elegant with a classic, flinty minerality counterbalancing soft, creamy fruit.
- 70 Meursault Clos du Cromin Olivier Leflaive Olivier Leflaive , Burgundy, France** £120.00
The Leflaive family has been rooted in Puligny Montrachet since 1717. In the 20th century Joseph Leflaive (1870-1953), a descendant of the founder, Claude Leflaive acquired parcels of prime premier and grand cru vineyards. His sons, Vincent and Jo, took over in 1953. In 1984 Olivier Leflaive, Jo's son, established with brother, Patrick, Olivier Leflaive Freres, which was set up to act as the negociant of Domaine Leflaive. The wine is structured and expresses hazelnut, white fruits and mirabelle. It is concentrated and gorgeous on the palate with a long and elegant finish.
- 75 Macon-Verze Domaines Leflaive, Burgundy, France** £65.00
Leflaive is one of the greatest and most highly rated producers of white wine in the world. Creamily fruited with a subdued buttery perfume, fine intensity, and a lovely burst of acidity on the finish. This is a super way of trying their wines without buying years in advance.
- 80 Puligny-Montrachet Domaine Francois Carillon, Burgundy, France** £120.00
A complex wine of subtle harmony. You can find blossom, ripe grapes, marzipan, hazelnut, lemon grass and green apple on the nose with freshly buttered hot toast and honey on the palate.
- 85 Bourgogne Blanc "Les Setilles" Olivier Leflaive, Burgundy, France** £59.00
This wine is no ordinary Bourgogne Blanc - 60% Puligny-Montrachet and 40% Meursault, from the superb Olivier Leflaive. Richly textured and full, with a wonderful streak of racy acidity which gives fine balance. Serious wine at a bargain price!
- 90 Cakebread Chardonnay, Napa Valley, U.S.A** £90.00
Over 30 years ago, Jack Cakebread came to photograph the Napa Valley for a book and ended up buying a vineyard. This forward-thinking, family-owned estate creates top quality Chardonnay, Which is rich, fresh and creamy on the palate with beautiful underlying structure.
- 100 Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru Domaine Bonneau du Martray, Burgundy, France** £300.00
To most, Domaine Bonneau du Martray is Corton Charlemagne - one of the very greatest Grand Cru white Burgundies. Synonymous with a style that combines richness, length, and concentration with an incomparable finesse and purity. It is also one of only two Domaines in Burgundy (the other being Domaine de la Romanée-Conti) to produce uniquely Grand Cru wines. Fresh, tight minerally nose with a stony earthy character.
- 105 Chardonnay Nelson Estate, Paarl, South Africa** £45.00
Acclaimed Cape Wine Master, Lisha Nelson, only produces wine from grapes that are grown on the estate. Her philosophy is to spare no expense and take a hands-on approach to tending the vineyards. Individual berry selection of grapes ensures premium quality from this medal winning wine maker.
- 110 Pouilly-Fuisse, Moulin du Pont Maison Auvigue, Burgundy, France** £59.00
A powerful and concentrated Pouilly-Fuisse with aromas of stone-fruit, toasty oak and a hint of honey. Already balanced and complex.
- 115 Rully Vauvry 1er Cru Olivier Leflaive, Burgundy, France** £90.00
Generous fruit, great texture and just plain delicious Chardonnay.
- 120 Saint-Aubin Dents de Chien 1er Cru Olivier Leflaive, Burgundy, France** £80.00
Fine gold in colour with light toasted spicy oak aroma. Smoothly ripe and full to taste with a long finish.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

125 Sauvignon Blanc Reserva, Los Camachos Chile £30.00
This is an elegant and distinctive white wine, grown around the beautiful Lake Vichuquén in the remote Curicó Valley. Coastal breezes rolling in from the Pacific help cool the vineyards, yielding a vibrant Sauvignon Blanc.

130 Sauvignon Blanc Eradus, Marlborough, New Zealand £39.00
A lovely vegetal and asparagus style of Sauvignon Blanc. This wine is delicious, rich and leafy fresh. Winner of 17 gold medals no less!

135 Sauvignon Blanc Nelson Estate, Paarl, South Africa £27.00
This is the first wine Lisha Nelson produced after taking over her father's vineyard. She then won a gold medal at the first attempt. Vibrant, fruity and perfect.

140 Sancerre Domaine de la Grande Maison Chaumeau-Balland, Loire, France £55.00
A tiny domain produces this; one of the finest Sancerre's to be found. Perfectly balanced fruit with a dry finish. Delicious with shellfish, fish and especially oysters!

145 Pouilly-Fume Les Chaumierres A&E Figeat, Loire, France £48.00
André Figeat sealed his fate as a vigneron when he fell in a vat of pressed juice at age 2! Now the family Winemaker, with state-of-the-art equipment, André selects grapes from individual sites according to their character. Fossil-rich, flinty soil gives this zesty, mineral Pouilly-Fumé its characteristic smokiness.

150 Touraine Salamandre Cellier du Beaujardin, Loire, France £29.00
Proving that the French can take on the New World at their own game. A super wine that is classical one in every respect, yet very modern.

155 Menetou-Salon Le Clos du Pressoir Vignobles Joseph Mellot, Loire, France £46.00
For five centuries, the Mellot dynasty have run this estate bordering Sancerre. The tiny Clos de Pressoir vineyard has just 4 hectares of Sauvignon vines and benefits from a similar, fossil-rich soil. The resulting wine is herbaceous with grapefruit notes and a creamy, crushed seashell minerality. Think lemon meringue pie!

RIESLING & GEWURZTRAMINER

160 Homer Riesling, Marlborough, New Zealand £35.00
Another wonderful creation by Michiel Eradus. His skill in the vineyard and with blending is undoubted. This particular Riesling, named after his dog, is just delicious...refreshing, served very chilled. Perfect with seafood, spicy food or simply as an aperitif.

170 Rheingau Riesling Kabinett Schloss Schonborn, Germany £36.00
A lovely wine from an award-winning estate that has been established for over 650 years. Good with asparagus and hollandaise sauce or with fresh fish.

175, Gewurztraminer Beblenheim Domaine Trapet Alsace, France £46.00
Andrée Trapet, wife of Jean-Louis Trapet of famed Domaine Trapet Père & Fils in Gevrey Chambertin, runs the estate with the help of her husband and their two sons Pierre and Louis. Andrée seeks to make a drier style of wine's with aromatic intrigue. Aromas of dried flowers, lemons and apples. Full body. Creamy and soft texture.

CHENIN BLANC

180 Old Vines Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch, South Africa £29.00
The quality of this fine Chenin Blanc can be attributed to access to some of the most remarkable old vineyards in the premium wine growing area of Stellenbosch. Hints of blossom, ripe apple and melon fruits overlaying a mineral core, leading to a fine long finish.

185 Les Fosses d'Hareng Vouvray, Loire, France £34.00
Catherine and Didier Champalou are respected growers based very near Vouvray. Attractive, soft, mineral restrained fruits on the nose, which is open, harmonious and fresh, with gentle acidity.

PINOT GRIGIO & GRIS

190 Pinot Grigio Luna Cecilia Beretta, Italy £30.00
Northern Italy's most fashionable wine! Grilled almonds with gooseberries, citrus fruits and a subtle underlying minerality.

195 Pinot Gris The Lane, Adelaide Hills, Australia. £40.00
John Edwards only makes 300 cases of wine a year - a real boutique vineyard. Pinot Gris with character, luscious honeysuckle and nutmeg.

200 Pinot Grigio La Tunella, Friuli, Italy £36.00
Fresh Pinot Grigio with rare depth and elegance from youthful, modern winery in Italy's classic Friuli region.

THE REMAINING WHITES

205 Friulano La Tunella, Italy £33.00
An elegant, creamy wine bursting with a floral note's and a stony minerality. Hard to find varietal this is the distillation of 30 years of work for Marco & Massimo the 3rd generation of the family to run this vineyard.

210 Il Carretto IGT Bianco di Puglia, Italy £25.00
Malvasia grapes, from the sunny and warm Puglia region in Italy. This grape variety needs lots of sun and warmth so it is at its best here. Zesty aromas and almondy notes make it a very versatile wine.

215 Terre de Lumiere Viognier Celliers Jean d'Alibert, France £25.00
Using the best Domaines that the Languedoc can offer, this small co-op produces super wines that are exceptional value for money. Spicy and aromatic.

220 Muscadet sur lie Jean François de Grand Mouton JF Guilbaud, Loire, France £27.00
A dry, steely white wine. The "sur lie" tradition involves the wine being bottled while still in contact with the sediment. This keeps the wine fresh and gives it a slight fizz and yeasty roundness. Flavours of citrus fruits and pepper on the finish.

225 Soave Classico DOC Brognoligo Cecilia Beretta, Italy £32.00
A showcase of the highly-regarded Brognoligo vineyards, located in the heart of the Soave region. This wine has ripe orchard fruit, a creamy texture and trademark minerality from the unique volcanic soils.

230 Grüner Veltliner Strass Allram, Austria £40.00
Discreet flavours of citrus fruit, herbs and hay flowers, with a hint of peppery spice and yeast. Elegant, mild acidity, good body and length. Plenty of extract - a fine combination of fruit, spice and minerals.

235 Pazo la Maza Albarino Adegas Galegas DO Rias Baixas, Spain £35.00
A lively and refreshing Albariño made in its indigenous region - DO Rias Baixas - a great accompaniment to a large array of seafood and shellfish dishes.

ROSÉ

240 La Brouette Rosé Producteurs Plaimont IGP Comte Tolosan, France £25.00
As pink as a partridge eye! Red fresh fruit nose with hints of wild strawberry and fruit drop. Very good with pork, shellfish or on its own.

245 Chateau la Tour de l'Eveque Rosé AOC Cotes de Provence, France £35.00
A classic style of Provence Rosé with vivacious red berry fruit, ripe nectarine and hints of sweet grapefruit. Its silky texture, delicate creaminess and vivid fruit make this delicious on its own or a wonderful match for a variety of food.

250 Nelson Estate Rosé, Paarl, South Africa £29.00
Shiraz/Cabernet Franc/Petit Verdot and Merlot combine to produce a pretty rosé from award winning wine maker Lisha Nelson.

251 Sof Campo di Sasso, Tuscany, Italy £60.00
A sumptuous Tuscan rosé from Sophia Antinori, scion of the great winemaking family. Cabernet & Syrah are used to great effect. Strawberries and cool citrus. Ripe yet crunchy, precise raspberry fruit. An excellent alternative to Provence

REDS

MERLOT AND MERLOT BLENDS

- 255 **Merlot Cakebread Cellars, Rutherford, California** £150.00
The majority of grapes in this wine come from the Suscol Springs Vineyard in south-eastern Napa Valley. A hilly, rocky, cool-climate site with well-drained volcanic soils and a desirable southern exposure which yields Merlot grapes with rich varietal flavours, bright, lively acidity, and fine structure for ageing.
- 260 **Merlot Bainskloof, Breede River Valley, South Africa** £26.00
From some of the Cape's most arid vineyards. Big and fleshy, very classical, and a must with food.
- 265 **L'Hospitalet de Gazin, Pomerol, France** £70.00
What one wants from a Pomerol - a perfect balance between classicism and hedonism, accessibility, suppleness and structure - one of the most celebrated Bordeaux sub-regions delivering here a perfect complement to food.
- 270 **Chateau Barrail du Blanc Grand Cru St-Emilion, Bordeaux, France** £54.00
Spicy and fruity with a heady aroma, everything a Grand Cru St-Emilion should be. Silky and velvety with real power.
- 275 **Terre Roteboeuf Grand Cru St-Emillion, Bordeaux, France** £275.00
Located in a high-sloped amphitheatre facing South and towards the rising sun. Richly aromatic on the nose and packed with blackcurrants, overripe cherries, liquorice, roasted caramel and vanilla notes.
- 280 **Pichikura Merlot Vinedos Marchigue, Chile** £25.00
Critically acclaimed, easy drinking and a great example of the quality now emerging from South America.
- 285 **Merlot Belvedere Cecilia Beretta, Veneto, Italy** £27.00
Soft and velvety red wine from prestige winery making small quantities of high-quality wines in the Veneto.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON AND CABERNET BLENDS

- 290 **Cabernet Sauvignon Domaine de Saissac Pays d'Oc, France** £29.00
This wine has delicious berry fruits and a slight touch of oak. It offers claret style drinking with a softer, sunnier edge.
- 295 **Cabernet Sauvignon Quinta de Chocapalha, Portugal** £37.00
Super wine from this much undervalued part of the wine world. Richly perfumed with notes of very ripe black fruit and floral notes, well combined with the flavour of vanilla.
- 300 **Chateau Phelan Segur, Saint-Estèphe, France** £95.00
Elegant and approachable with good structure and already silky tannins. Fruit purity is quite evident with remarkable concentration on the palate.
- 305 **"19th Meeting" Cabernet Sauvignon The Lane, Adelaide Hills, Australia** £70.00
Assisted by his son Marty, John Edwards produces wines with real finesse. European in style but with an Aussie twist. Fine length and good tannins - a real occasion wine.
- 310 **Il Pino di Biserno Tenuta di Biserno, Tuscany, Italy** £90.00
This positively delicious Super Tuscan is made of Cabernet Sauvignon, Sangiovese, Syrah and Merlot. This is another of the new, young estates that will be fascinating to follow over the next few years.
- 315 **Le Cupole IGT Tenuta di Trinoro, Tuscany, Italy** £70.00
Delicate, feminine and a uniquely wonderful blend from southern Tuscany. Andrea Franchetti is one of the most respected wine makers in Italy and this wine is no exception.
- 320 **Chateau Saint-Aubin** £55.00
Fine deep colour, good concentration of ripe small berry fruit. Quite closed but well-knit and good intensity of flavour. Attractive middle palate with a harmonious long finish.
- 325 **Cabernet Merlot, Nelson Estate, Paarl, South Africa** £40.00
Rich, fruity Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot blend from award winning family producers, Nelson Estate. A small, family owned vineyard situated in the Paarl region. Wine maker Lisha Nelson ensures that the utmost care goes into producing every bottle.

MALBEC

330 Malbec, Finca Bella Vista Achaval-Ferrer, Argentina £150.00
Finca Bella Vista is a seven hectare single vineyard, Planted over 100 years ago the vineyard here is 980 metres above sea level and the wine is 100% pure Malbec. Matured for 15 months in French oak Bella Vista is dense and rich in texture with firm and fine-grained tannins. Vibrant, strong aromas of blackberry, violet, dark raspberry, and crushed stone. The palate is super-concentrated with an utterly silky finish and a perfumed back end. A thrillingly joyful wine from this super star wine maker.

335 Malbec Bodega Ruca Malen, Mendoza, Argentina £35.00
Bodega Ruca Malen is a small winery in Mendoza started in 1999 with the aim to produce quality wines organically.
Fabulous concentration of dark cherry fruit layered with a creamed richness. A heady dash of spice makes for effortless enjoyment.

SHIRAZ AND SHIRAZ BLENDS

350 Double Trouble Shiraz Cabernet Barossa Boy, Australia £50.00
This is made with old vines, 35-40 year old fruit, in the Barossa Valley. It is picked ripe and nestles in the best French oak for 18 months. Dense and creamy with a heart of black fruits, liquorice and Belgian chocolate, with plenty of savoury notes adding to the long, dry finish.

355 Shiraz Viognier The Lane, Adelaide Hills, Australia £40.00
Only limited amounts of this wine are produced annually at this highly regarded vineyard. Raspberry, blackberry, with a gentle tobacco quality adding complexity. No rough edges with this wine.

360 Shiraz Nelson Estate, Paarl, South Africa £45.00
Nelson Estate is situated in the Agter-Paarl region of South Africa - an area well known for its high quality wines. Lisha Nelson's Shiraz is a perfect example, with silky dark fruit, rich mocha notes and a smoky finish.

365 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Château de Beaucastel, Rhone, France £175.00
Beaucastel needs no introduction, regarded by many as one of the top estates in the Rhone.
Notes of meaty and cherry fruit, the palate is rich, full, and deep, with a dense and grippy character.

370 Syrah Intipalka Vinas Queirolo, Peru. £28.00
Located in the Valle de Ica the Queirolo family have been growing vines since 1880. The unique desert climate, with warm sunny days and cool nights, produces a Syrah with great structure, a bright acidity and delicate aromas of raspberry and sweet spices.

TEMPRANILLO

380 Rioja Joven 50/50, Altos de Baroja, Spain £26.00
Bodegas Zugober 50/50 Rioja Joven is an excellent fruit driven style of young Rioja. Made from 100% Tempranillo grapes the wine display aromas of strawberries with a touch of licorice and a fresh and fruity palate

385 Rioja Rioja Gran Reserva Bodegas Zugober, Spain £74.00
Only produced in exceptional vintages from 50 year old vines and aged for 24 months in French and American oak with a further 36 months in bottle prior to release. Long on the palate with exquisite, spicy, fruity flavours this is an outstanding wine, to be enjoyed on special occasions, when its complexity can be most appreciated.

395 PSI Bodegas y Vinedos Alnardo, Ribera del Duero, Spain £75.00
Peter Sisseck, Bordeaux-trained Danish winemaker creator of Dominio de Pingus, seeks to capture and protect the very essence of the Ribera del Duero, by revisiting and reinventing tradition. The resulting wine is a lovely, versatile red, with a sense of place using 100-year-old vine fruit. Richly fruited and darkly spiced.

PINOT NOIR

400 Mercurey Les Montots Domaine de Villaine, Burgundy, France £80.00

When Aubert de Villaine came to Burgundy to look after Domaine de la Romanée-Conti, he was looking for a place to live away from the Côte de Nuits. He fell in love with Bouzeron and bought a rundown estate. Today, it has 21ha and is managed by his nephew Pierre de Benoist. This wine has inviting aromas of spice and red fruit with savoury notes. Rounded, yet elegant with pure Pinot Noir characters.

405 Pinot Noir, Elephant Hill, Central Otago, New Zealand £55.00

Elephant Hill is a family-owned estate making premium, hand crafted wines. This wine showcases the bold and attractive nature of Central Otago Pinot with its fruit-forward charm, delicate floral notes and beautifully soft tannin structure.

410 Pinot Nero La Tunella, Friuli Venezia Giulia, Italy £40.00

Soft and spicy Pinot Nero with attractive, ripe fruit; from modern, family estate in North East Italy

415 Marsannay Domaine Trapet Pere et Fils, Burgundy, France £75.00

Delicious, high quality Marsannay from leading Burgundian producer, Trapet. Jet-shot plum-ruby, this reveals red and dark fruit and lovely mineral definition on both the nose and palate. A lovely wine.

420 Gevrey-Chambertin Cuvee Ostrea Domaine Trapet Pere et Fils, Burgundy, France £135.00

Using grapes from three parcels on unique fossil-rich limestone soils. It has a very composed and harmonious bouquet: joyful blackcurrant and raspberry fruit, hints of orange sorbet and orange rind emerging with time in the glass. The palate is medium-bodied with very fine tannin

PINOTAGE

425 Pinotage Rhebokskloof, Paarl, South Africa £34.00

The perfect choice with any red meat. This hybrid grape has only been around since the 40's but is now known around the world and immediately associated with South Africa. This is a fine example.

GRENACHE, GAMAY + BLENDS

430 Fleurie Grand-Pre Domaine Lathuiliere Gravallon, Beaujolais, France £35.00

Delicious red berry and violet scented Fleurie from exceptionally old vines. Perfect with lamb.

435 Moulin-a-Vent Coeur de Terroir Vieilles Vignes Domaine Labruyere, Beaujolais, France £55.00

Made from 100% Gamay grapes which are all hand-picked and aged in oak barrels for 13 months. The palate is soft with notes of red fruits and a touch of black chocolate intermingled with very fine, spicy and refreshing tannins to finish.

440 Little Tacker GSM Barossa Boy, Australia £45.00

The ultimate Barossa wine blend from Trent Burge - a young man and 6th generation of the famous Barossa winemaking family - dedicated to reinterpreting the region for new generations. A generous and textured wine with lively fruits of the forest, giving way to earthy notes of dark chocolate, toasty vanilla and spicy cloves.

THE REMAINING REDS

445 Barbera d'Alba Giulia Negri, Piedmont, Italy £55.00

Using 100% Barbera, fruit harvested from a North West facing ridge. Dark red and strong, with persistent wild aromas. Full-bodied and richly fruity, it is sustained by a refreshing and noteworthy acidity.

450 Licanten Cabernet Franc Idahue Estate La Ronciere, Chile £35.00

Produced from slow-ripening grapes found by the sea in Licanten – one of the only four DOs recognised for its unique terroir in 2018. Viña La Ronciere is the only producer in this new DO. There, it combines traditional methods.

and precision techniques to make terroir-driven wines. Notes of cherries, violets and cinnamon. It is fresh and concentrated on the palate, with a touch of toffee and spearmint. It has firm, ripe tannins and a long finish.

455 Franchetti Tenuta di Passopisciaro IGT, Sicily £130.00

Made with 100% Nerello Mascalese grapes, Andrea Franchetti utilizes the altitude and climate, allowing the grapes to ripen very late in the season - as late as November in some cases. Bright cherry and pomegranate, toast/smoke and earth. Silky tannins and a long finish.

460 Amarone Classico Terre di Cariano Cecilia Beretta, Italy £90.00

Sweet vanilla with plums on the nose and a peppery spice. Dry, dark and firm but very fine tannins. Excellent fresh finish. Gambero Rosso's Tre Bicchieri award winner no less.

465 **Chianti Classico Terre di Prenzano Vignamaggio, Tuscany , Italy** £45.00
100% Sangiovese that see's approximately one year in large wooden casks and then several further months in bottle prior to release. The resulting wine is classic Chianti Classico with intense trademark Sangiovese cherry and raspberry fruits to the fore.

470 **Barolo La Tartufaia Giulia Negri, Piedmont, Italy** £85.00
Very accessible Barolo from a small family-run estate in Monforte d'Alba. Warm, spicy berries, attractive cedar notes,
dried autumnal fruits and dark chocolate – complex, layered and seductively textured.

DESSERT

475 **Château Septy, Bordeaux, France (Half)** £4.25 50ml
A super alternative to some of the pricier offerings in Bordeaux. A good partner with lemon tart or any dairy based pudding. The nose has notes of honey and ripe fruits, the palate is delicate with a long finish.

480 **San Emilio Pedro Ximinez Solera Reserva Emilio Lustau, Spain** £6.25 50ml
Very sweet, smooth, pronounced and delicious, just like dried raisins or sweet grape juice. Awarded Gold Medal at the IWC. Very good with sticky toffee pudding or drizzled over ice cream!

485 **Noble Late Harvest Semillon Nelson Estate, South Africa (Half)** £6.95 50ml
The wine shows an attractive rich, golden yellow colour. Dried apricots, peaches and hints of pineapple shows on the nose with delicate honey flavours. The taste is full and finishes with a lingering aftertaste.
